VENDOR AGREEMENT – Event Rules and Guidelines

- **Booth space** is limited. Please return application with fee before September 30, 2010 to avoid \$25 late fee. Acceptance and booth location are at the discretion of the Texas Dragon Boat Association and requires payment in full. Vendors will receive a confirmation or rejection call on or before October 8, 2010.
- **Late fee** All applications postmarked after September 30, 2010 must pay a \$25 late fee. Payments received within 30 days of the festival must be by cash, cashier's check or money order.
- **Merchandise** - All merchandise must be G-rated and suitable for a family-oriented event. Festival reserves the right to prohibit the sale of any merchandise we deem not appropriate.
- **Equipment** - Vendor provides tent, chairs, tables, and all other setup equipment.
- **Electricity** \$45 per **110v-20-amp outlet**. A \$25 fee will be charged for each additional 20-amp outlet. Vendors must provide their own-grounded 100 ft. heavy-duty extension cord. Generators must be pre approved.
- **Vendor Site Assignments & Check In** All vendor spaces are assigned. Vendors must check in with Vendor Coordinator at the Information Tent for space assignment.
- **Vendor Setup** Friday 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM* OR Saturday at 6:00 AM
- **Hours of operation** Vendors must be ready for business by 8:30 a.m. Saturday and will not be allowed to break down their booth until the festival closes at 4:30 p.m.
- **Vehicles & Parking** Vendors will have a designated unload and load area on Friday Night and Saturday before 7:30 AM. Vehicles must be moved before set up of booth begins. All vehicles must be off site by 7:30 AM Saturday.
- **Sales Tax** It is the vendor's responsibility to adhere to city and state tax guidelines for the collection and payment of sales tax. The Texas Sales Tax Info Line is 800.252.5555.
- **Food Vendors & Health Permits** A City of Sugar Land Health Permit is mandatory. If you plan to distribute food or drinks you MUST secure a health permit. Contact Jessica Spies, Health Inspector at 281.275.2278 before September 27th to begin the permitting process. A copy of your health permit must be provided when you check in for the event. Food vendors without health permits will not be allowed to set up and there will be no refunds.
- **Liability Insurance** Food vendors must maintain a minimum of \$250,000 liability insurance.
- **Propane** Propane is not allowed. No exceptions!!!
- **Waste disposal** Each vendor is responsible to keep their stall and the surrounding area clean. Vendors are required to provide their own garbage receptacles and garbage bags.
- **Inclement Weather*** If the Regatta is canceled by Texas Dragon Boat Association Officials due to inclement weather you will be notified by the Vendor Coordinator. Booth rental fees are nonrefundable however; vendors will receive a 50% discount on the next TDBA event.
- **Security** Vendor is solely responsible for the security and safety of their cash, equipment, goods, inventory, supplies, or other property.

RELEASE: Applicant's signature on this application releases and forever discharges Texas Dragon Boat Association, all sponsoring organizations, their elected officials, directors, contractors, employees, and volunteers from any responsibility, personal liability, or claims of loss or damage arising out of, or in conjunction with participation in the Festival. The Festival is not responsible for any injury sustained by exhibitors, patrons, or guests. Applicant stores and exhibits their goods at their own risk. In addition, I/we have read and agree to abide by all festival regulations stated in this packet, or risk removal from Festival site without refund.
